

LETTER BEING DELIVERED TO PARK PROPERTIES:

Dear Local Resident/Business,

As the date of the 2015 Ikano Robin Hood Marathon and Half Marathon approaches we are writing to tell you that the event is coming to your area, and of the traffic management measures which may affect you.

As organisers, we appreciate there will be some disruption, which we hope you understand is unavoidable when staging such a large mass participation event and we thank you for your patience and cooperation in advance of race day.

General Information

Event: The Ikano Robin Hood Marathon and Half Marathon
 Date: Sunday 27th September 2015
 Start Time: 09.30am from Victoria Embankment

Road closures

We have worked very closely with Nottingham City Council to agree a full traffic management system which will be safe for the runners and cause the minimum amount of disruption to residents and other road users. However, there will be times when some roads will be closed to traffic. This is necessary to host such a large road race and we ask for your patience and cooperation during the short time the race will be passing your area.

Entering a Marathon or Half Marathon is not for the faint hearted and takes determination, commitment and a lot of will power.

Even if you're not a runner or don't know anyone who is taking part we hope you will join in the fun by cheering the runners as they go past, most of whom will be raising thousands of pounds for local charities and will really appreciate your support.
